Low Complexity Medical Decision-Making requires only slightly more intellectual energy than straightforward MDM. The acuity of care remains minimal. For example, this level of MDM is required for a level 3 office visit or a level 3 office consult (99243). The degree of risk remains quite low and corresponds to a patient with one chronic illness which is completely stable.
